

RE: Event Plans for Van's Bar and Grill
June 13th -17th 2013

1. Wristbands will be given to customers over the age of 21; those persons that do not have a wristband will not be able to purchase alcoholic beverages. After 9pm, Persons under 21 will not be allowed into the tent.
2. We will have a tent with 3 sides on it, one with entry into the tent.
3. A security guard will posted at the entrance of the tent to maintain order and to check id's for admittance into the tent and also inspecting the parking lot from time to time.
4. We have worked with the fire department to make sure we are going to be in compliance with everything they ask and have a checklist of theirs to double check.
5. We have told both neighboring businesses about the event, TAP and Yankee Clipper and no one has raised a complaint.
6. The sound will be kept at a reasonable decibel level, between 90-95db which is comparable to that of an electric saw and the interior of a bus. Low end HZ (Bass) will be kept to a minimum as the sound wave of low end frequency travels the farthest. The stage will be set up facing the back entrance of Van's Bar. This will have the customers act like a sound barrier along with the back of the bar and the two walls of the theater and On Deck. See ex. 1
