

COMMON COUNCIL
July 6, 2010

A regular meeting of the Common Council was called to order at 8:04 p.m. by Mayor Birmingham. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Roll call: Wiegand, Vandertie, Lodi, Abeyta, Mann, Benzshawel, and Schlicht were present.

Schlicht/Benzshawel to adopt agenda. Carried.

The Council reviewed the unfinished business list.

Abeyta/Wiegand to approve following bills: General Fund - \$81,371.77, Capital Fund - \$86,379.83, Cable TV - \$4,593.36, TID #2 - \$363.00, TID #3 - \$530.33, and Solid Waste Enterprise Fund - \$6,069.72 for a grand total of \$179,308.01. Roll call: All voted aye. Carried.

Wiegand/Mann to read in title only, the first reading of ordinance re: Rezone property located at 43 S. 2nd Ave. from Heavy Industrial (I-2) to Central Business District (C-2). Carried.

Lodi/Schlicht to read in title only and adopt the second reading of ordinance re: Creating Section 12.075 of the Municipal Code (Cross connection control & backflow.) Carried.

Wiegand/Schlicht to read in title only and adopt the second reading of ordinance re: Amending Section 27.12(2) of Municipal Code – Temporary Signs – and Creating Section 27.12(2)(c)8 of Municipal Code – Sign Code. Carried.

Lodi/Mann to read in title only and adopt the second reading of ordinance re: Repealing and Recreating Sections 9.08, 10.23, 12.05, 12.08, creating Chapter 34 of the Municipal Code – Regulation & Licensing of Animals. Carried.

A request from Sturgeon Bay Yacht Club for contribution to Venetian Night Regatta on August 7, 2010 was presented. John Purinton, SBYC Secretary, addressed the Council and requested a donation for fireworks. Wiegand/Mann to contribute \$500.00 to Sturgeon Bay Yacht Club for Venetian Night on August 7, 2010. COMMUNITY PROTECTION & SERVICES COMMITTEE

Introduced by Mann. Schlicht/Lodl to adopt. Discussion took place regarding the history of this item, the notification to residents of the possibility of removing streetlights, whether or not there could be a trial period for turning off some lights. It was noted that there are approximately 1,200 - 1,300 street lights and SBU came up with a potential 117 that could be removed. After comments from residents, 69 lights did not receive any comments. Lodl/Schlicht to amend the motion to add "that besides the five streetlights recommended from CPS, to remove streetlights that had no comment at all and the one that said "remove" which is 69 total and to revisit again in one year." Discussion continued regarding public safety and how to inform residents. Vote taken on amendment. Roll call: Lodl and Schlicht voted aye. Wiegand, Vandertie, Abeyta, Mann, and Benzshawel voted no. Amendment failed. Vote taken on original motion. Roll call: All voted no. Motion failed.

RECOMMENDATION

We, the Parking & Traffic Committee, hereby recommend to Council to approve the Street Closure Application for the Door County Triathlon as submitted.
