Architectural Statement: <i>This two-story commercial structure is ornately detailed at the second story with pressed metal in a Classical Revival pattern. This pressed metal facade is unique within the district and appears to have been part of the original design, rather than a later "modernization" (A) The modifications of the storefront level are, however, so out of character with the buildings original design quality that its original architectural integrity has been seriously compromised.
