EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Title: Liquor License for Hotel Lindgren


Background: Sawyer Hotel Development, LLC (Bob Papke, agent), which is the developer for the proposed Hotel Lindgren on the West Waterfront, requests that the city reserve a "Class B" liquor license for the hotel. The City currently has one regular "Class B" license available and also has two additional licenses that become available through the adoption of the Premier Economic Development District (PEDD) ordinance. The district includes the hotel site.

Mr. Papke and his investors believe the liquor license will enhance the viability of the hotel project and the PEDD ordinance was adopted in part to obtain another license that could be used for the hotel. Because Sawyer Hotel Development, LLC does not currently own the hotel site and doesn't have a facility that the liquor license can be issued to, a formal application, approval, and issuance of the license cannot occur. Thus, the developer is simply seeking assurance that a liquor license will be held for the hotel.

Currently, there are no other requests for either issuing or reserving a license within the PEDD.

Fiscal Impact: There is no fiscal impact to agreeing to hold a license for the hotel project. If a license under the PEDD ordinance is ultimately issued, the initial fee for the license is \$30,000. The hotel, if built, has an estimated property value of about \$8.2 Million.

Recommendation: Staff recommends the City agree to reserve one of the PEDD liquor licenses for the proposed hotel, provided there is a valid development contract between Sawyer Hotel Development, LLC and the City.


